Why Preschool Lessons?

- Numerous studies reveal the piano to be a powerful tool for developing mathematical thinking and help facilitate early neural connections in the brain needed for later mathematical and spacial understanding.
- Our preschool lessons are an encouraging, positive and enjoyable first experience in music lessons geared specifically for 3-5 year old's to ensure your child's long-term enjoyment of the piano.
- Our preschool piano curriculum combines beginning piano skills that create connections that facilitate mathematical understanding in the future and a love of the arts. Students will start playing on the piano at the FIRST lesson!

What to Expect:

- Each week, your child will participate in musical activities both on and off the bench: created build piano to confidence, increase enjoyment and solidify musical concepts. Songs, rhymes, games, and imaginative activities keep your child engaged and begging for the next lesson!
- Daily home practice will include several fun activities for the parent and student that are designed to reinforce what was learned in the lesson and to create "bonding on the bench" time at home.
- You can help your child to be successful by providing a home instrument and by adding regular time at the piano into your family's routine.
- WunderKeys books encourage exploration of the piano in ways that are accessible and appropriate for this age group and will prepare them for learning to read notated music!
